NWESC reserves the right to disapprove any applicant for any reason, and we are not obligated to share those reasons.

Also, be sure to notify your vet and farrier references that a representative from our group will be calling and authorize them to release information to us.

NWESC Adoption Process:

Upon review of your Adoption Application, we will contact you for a brief phone interview to set up a time for you to meet the horse(s) you are interested in. If after meeting the horse(s), you wish to proceed with the adoption, and NWESC also that you are a good match for the horse in question, we will proceed with a site visit and reference checks. Upon approval of your application, you will sign and return the Adoption Contract, along with applicable adoption fee(s), and arrange transport of your horse to his new home.
